

# WELCOME TO THE NET GENERATION PLAYTRACKER



The Net Generation PlayTracker helps players ages 5-10 and their parents navigate and track their own development progress. Now, players will collect play points and win points after playing in USTA Team Challenges, USTA Junior Team Tennis and USTA Junior Circuit events.

10U players and their parents may access their PlayTracker points within their USTA.com account profile, underneath the “Family” tab. Here, you may see the player’s current competition ball color, coach-assigned skill level (if applicable) and total points at each competitive level.

## BALL COLOR & AGE REQUIREMENTS

- Players are recommended to reach at least 1,000 points in red ball and 1,000 points in orange ball before moving to green ball
- Players are eligible to register for green ball events at 9 years old
- A Coach Assessment is available for players that are 7 or 8 years old who have the skills to advance to green ball early
- All players are required to collect at least 1,000 win points and 500 play points in green ball to advance to yellow ball
- A maximum of 500 points (400 win points and 100 play points) can be collected at any green ball event.
